Congratulations on a successful HLC Visit! We are truly grateful for all your hard work, especially related to assessment, to prepare for the visit. They noticed!

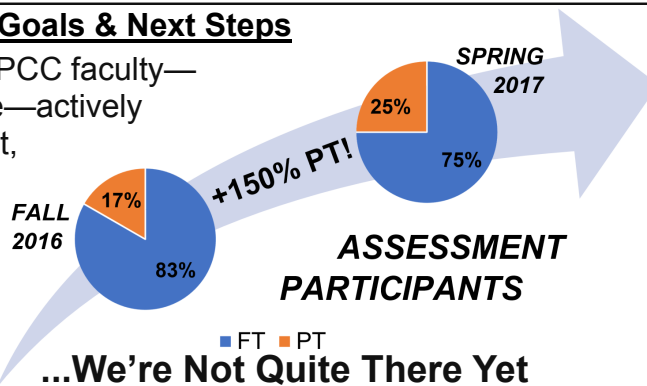

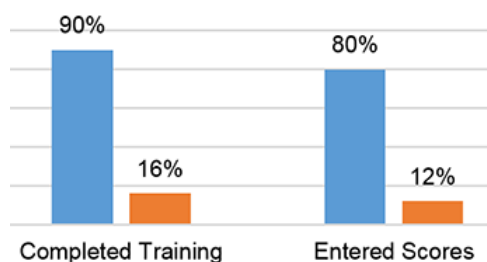
