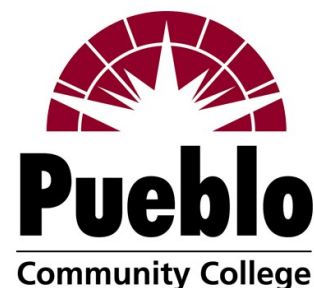

## REMINDER: Enter Fall 2017 Scores

As you wrap up the semester, don't forget that when you submit grades in the Portal, you should also be entering scores in eLumen.

**Minimum Expectation:** Complete at least one assessment (score students on one rubric) in at least one class each semester.

**Timeline:** Every semester, the grading deadline and the scoring deadline are the same, which means you have **until 12/18 to enter scores**.

**Support:** If you have any questions about what you should be using to assess your students or how to get everything into eLumen, contact your Chair, Division Lead, and/or ASL Coordinator (contact info below).

## Look How Far We've Come! Since this time last year...

### eLumen Training Completion

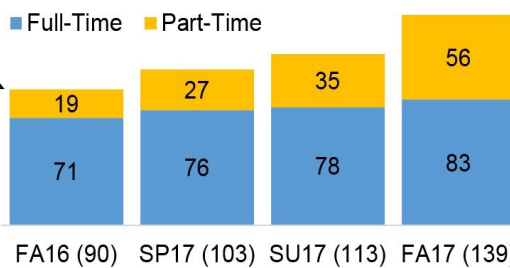
- 154% increase overall
- 90% of all FT faculty trained
- # of PT instructors nearly tripled!

### Program-Level Development

- 420 Learning Outcomes (PSLOs)
- 108 PSLOs mapped to ISLOs
- 156 PSLOs with assessment rubrics

### Participation Rates: Completion of Planned Assessments

- Fall 2016: 224 completed assessments (65% of those planned)
- Fall 2017: 274 planned assessments (13.5% completed so far!)
