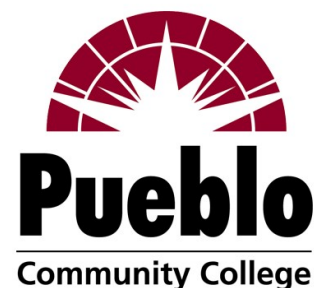

## Spring 2020 Classes Now Available in eLumen

All Spring 2020 classes have now been loaded into eLumen, which means Department Chairs can start sending out rubrics, and faculty can begin entering assessment scores.

- If there are no rubrics linked to your classes, remember you can use the “Find Assessment” button to link any of our college-wide rubrics yourself!
- If there are extra/missing students from your rosters: contact Liz Medendorp with the corrections needed, including student names and S numbers
- If you have any new/revised assessment rubric, fill out this simple [Rubric Development Template](#) and send the completed version to Liz Medendorp to have it built into eLumen for you to use for this semester’s assessment.

## Exciting New Opportunity for Customized Professional Development

In assessment, obtaining consistent results within departments or programs can seem impossible, but no longer! Your solution is at hand!
