Important End-of-Semester Reminders

What's Expected of Me?

All faculty and instructors are expected to complete **at least one assessment** in **at least one class each semester you teach**—more are encouraged!

When Is the Deadline?

Student assessment scores must be submitted via eLumen by the grading deadline—that means the Fall 2021 deadline is **MONDAY, MAY 16!**

How Do I Complete an Assessment?

What does it mean to complete an assessment? It's simpler than you might expect!

- 1) Select a **rubric** that makes sense for your course—you have lots of choices!
 - one of our five [college-wide rubrics](#)
 - the newly added [PCC Flex Self-Assessment](#)
 - a departmental or course-specific rubric developed for your program
 - *Got another rubric of your own you'd like to use for your assessment? Send it to eLumenSupport@pueblocc.edu!*
- 2) Choose an existing **assignment, project, or activity** from your class that allows your students to demonstrate the skills described in your selected rubric.
- 3) According to your selected rubric, **score** your students' performance on the chosen assignment, reflecting their mastery level the skills described.
- 4) Log into our assessment platform, [eLumen](#), and **enter** your students' scores.

eLumen FAQ/Troubleshooting

HOW DO I LOG IN? Access eLumen from the portal (faculty tab) or directly at pueblocc.elumenapp.com (no http or www); username = S number; password requires at least one special character and is separate from other PCC accounts. You can set (or reset) your password any time with the "Forgot Password?" link and PCC email!

WHY DON'T I SEE MY CLASSES? Check that you have the right program selected from the drop-down menu at the top left (next to your name and "Faculty" role).

HOW DO I ADD A RUBRIC TO MY CLASS? Click the "Find Assessment" button for the library of all available rubrics!

WHY CAN'T I OPEN THE RUBRIC (NO SCORECARD ICONS ARE SHOWING)? You'll need to click the "Add Activity" link in order to enter a title and description for the assignment or project you are assessing—only then will the scorecard icons appear!

HOW DO I MAKE SURE MY ASSESSMENT IS COMPLETE? Go to the "Courses" tab and look for the green checkmark to verify that all students have been scored completely—don't forget to check "Not Assessed" (N/A) for any who dropped the class or didn't complete the activity/assignment!
